Conference Coffee Cozy

1. Ch 27, join in round with a sl st
2. Round 1: ch 2, starting in same st as the ch2, hdc in each chain to the end of the round (27); pm in last st of the round.
3. Rounds 2 - 8: hdc to the end of the round. Replace marker in the last stitch of each round (27).
4. Cut yarn and fo. Weave in ends.
5. You're done! Slip onto your takeaway cup and enjoy!

Conference Cat Coaster

1. Form a mc and secure
2. Round 1: work 6 dc in mc, sl st to join; pm
3. Round 2: work 2 tch, sc in same stitch; work 2 sc in next 5 dc (12); pm
4. Round 3: [work 2 sc in first st, sc in next st] rpt to end of row (18); pm
5. Round 4: [work 2 sc in first st, sc in next 2 st] rpt to end of row (24); pm
6. Round 5: [work 2 sc in first st, sc in next 3 st] rpt to end of row (30); pm
7. Round 6: sc in first 3 st, [2 sc in next 2 st, sc in next 4 st] rpt brackets 5 times more, 2sc next st, sc in next st (36); pm
8. Round 7: 2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 st, 2 sc in next st, sc
TAIL: ch 9, hdc in second ch from hook, work 4 hdc in next ch, hdc in next 5 ch, hdc into side of last sc from round 7
Round 7 cont: sk next sc, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 st, remove st marker, sc in next 7 st, work inv join
6. Cut yarn and fo. Weave in ends.
7. Feeling cheeky? Use a contrasting colour to embroider a small starburst in the centre of the coaster—instant cat bum!
